- ◆ What is the genre of the story?
- ◆ A title can indicate content, show the purpose, or raise curiosity. What you think the title of the book indicates?
- ◆ Make predictions while you read.
- ◆ What is the problem in the story? How do you think it will be solved?
- ◆ Who are the main characters?
- ◆ Do you like or dislike the characters? Why?
- ◆ Choose a character. Why was this character important in the story?
- ◆ What does the dialogue tell you about the characters? Do they talk the way people talk? Why or why not?
- ◆ Suppose you had a chance to meet one of the characters. What would you say to him or her?
- ◆ Describe the main events that have happened so far.
- ◆ What do you think the author's message will be? Why do you think that?
- ◆ Where does the story take place? Describe the setting.
- ◆ Have you ever been to a place similar to the setting? Explain.
- ◆ When does the story take place ~ long ago, in the future, or in the present? How do you know?
- ◆ Discuss any illustrations that are in the book.
- ◆ What words has the author used so far to help you:
  - \* see things in the story?
  - \* hear things in the story?
  - \* feel things in the story?
